Ponymåling – nyt FEI reglement 2023

Der er udkommet nyt FEI veterinær reglement for 2023.

Heri fremgår det at ponyer der starter CAI1,2,3* gerne må stille til start uden officiel FEI- måling. Det er kun hvis Teknisk Delegeret, TD, til et stævne vurderer ponyen til at være over tilladt mål at TD kan stille krav om at ponyen stilles til FEI måling indenfor samme kalenderår. Indtil ponyen er målt må den gerne fortsat starte FEI stævner.

Ponyer der starter CAIO og FEI VM skal have gyldig FEI ponymåling når de stiller til start.

Bliver en pony målt for høj i forhold til FEI reglement må den ikke længere starte ponyklasser.

Uddrag fra det opdaterede reglement for 2023 er sakset ind nedenfor:

FEI Veterinary Regulations 2023

Article 1080

Regulatory Height

- 1. FEI Ponies must be measured in at an FEI Measuring Session and be issued with an Interim or Lifetime Measuring Certificate in order to be allowed to take part in FEI Pony Competitions with the exception to the conditions described in Article 1081.16.
- 2. Ponies' regulatory height at the withers must not exceed:
- 148cm without shoes (any measurement between 148.1cm and 148.9cm will be rounded down to 148.0cm); and
- 149cm with shoes (any measurement between 149.1cm and 149.9cm will be rounded down to 149.0cm.
- 3. Driving Ponies in Pairs and Four-in-Hands may not be less than 108 cm without shoes, or 109 cm with shoes. Single Ponies must not be less than 120cms without shoes, 121cms with shoes.

Ponies competing in CAI1*, CAI2* and CAI3* Events of all classes and Athlete categories may compete without an Interim or Lifetime Measuring Certificate. In such Events the TD may request that a Pony that is suspected to exceed the regulatory height is measured at a Measuring Session within the same calendar year. If the Pony is "measured in" at that Measuring Session, the Pony must then be issued with an FEI Interim or Lifetime Measuring Certificate in order to continue competing as a Pony. Any Ponies suspected to exceed the regulatory height are permitted to compete until they have been measured at a Measuring Session. If the Pony is Measured Out, it can no longer compete as a Pony.

Ponies competing in CAIOs and Championships require an Interim or Lifetime Measuring Certificate to compete in these Events.

4. The measuring veterinarians will put a remark in the passport: with shoes /without shoes, on the identification page.
